

Hats

Our school community (through Governing Council) supports the policy which requires students to wear wide brimmed or protective hats terms 1 and 4.

Teachers are responsible for the daily checking of hats. Students without Sunsafes hats remain in shaded areas not past The Block. Class teachers will initially follow up with students, then parents. The leadership team will provide intervention when alerted to regular non compliance any time any term, **No hats will be worn indoors.**

We do not 'lend' hats from lost property to students- only named hats are returned.

OUR DRESS CODE

Purpose

To ensure the safety of students
(So we can easily identify our students on School grounds and in the Community)
To promote a sense of identity.
To support families by reducing peer/ media pressure to wear certain items.
To develop and maintain a high standard of appearance.

Without appropriate dress code students may not be able to take part in excursions or may find play areas restricted. This especially applies to the oval where we need to quickly identify students.

Clothing That Is **NOT** Suitable

Hoodies, jackets and windcheaters that are patterned extensively, fur trimmed or are not in dress code colours
Midriff, sleeveless or tank tops
Low cut jeans and micro-shorts
Black pants
Makeup, dangling earrings & large necklaces
Logo's and printed images that are larger than school logo)
Coloured stripes and patterns
Camouflage print

Guidelines for Accepted Clothing

Pants

Pants in navy (including 'track pants')
Jeans- Blue (not blue-black)
Stripes in school colours are OK (approx 1-2cm)
School team clothing
Non patterned accessories in school colours.

Shorts

Same colours as pants and appropriate length



Polo Shirts

Navy, Sky Blue or White (not aqua or fluoro tones)
School team shirts & tops
NB: State SAPSASA clothing is worn for negotiated special occasions but not as part of regular dress code.

Windcheaters/ jumpers and jackets

Navy Blue or school jacket including school team tops

Navy blue/ school tartan

Footwear

Thongs/ heeled shoes and crocs are not acceptable. Footwear should enclose the toe and heel and be appropriate for physical activity.
